White Wine

2015 Meursault Chevalières, Domaine Coche Bizouard £82.00

Top Domaine wine and great vintage have delivered a round and voluptuous wine with plenty of grip and structure.

2016 Hunting Hill Chardonnay, New Zealand £71.00

Here is a wine which more than once has overcome top quality white Burgundy in blind tastings. It is mineral, concentrated, structured and elegant. A world class Chardonnay.

Red Wine

2011 Le Cigare Volant, Bonny Doon Vineyard, Central Coast, California £105.00

Randall Grahm's brilliant take on Châteauneuf which now owes more to Northern Rhône or even Burgundy. Made from Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault and Mourvedre.

2013 Chianti Classico Fondodi £65.00

Leather and tobacco taking over now from sour cherry and plum notes in this very fine Chianti.

2011 Vosne-Romanee 'Aux Réas', Domaine A.F, France £105.00

Lovely gentle maturing Pinot.

2009 Château Bernadotte, Haut Medoc £69.00

"Lush, ripe and concentrated" 90 pts Stephen Tanzer

2008 Château Grand Puy Lacoste, Pauillac, £115.00
