Below you will find a selection of wines specially chosen by Tim Hart and Dominique Baduel. These wines have been singled out as holding something particularly special, that are worth noting and perhaps a couple more pounds. These wines are only held in small quantities and may only feature for a short time so please enjoy them while they last.

## **White Wine**

2014 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru les Chaumées, £93.00  
Domaine Philippe Colin, France

This wine consistently scores over 90 points from the pundits. It is fat rich honeyed but balanced with wonderful Chassagne structure and minerality.

2016 Hunting Hill Chardonnay, New Zealand £69.00

Here is a wine which more than once has overcome top quality white Burgundy in blind tastings. It is mineral, concentrated, structured and elegant. A world class Chardonnay.

## **Red Wine**

2011 Le Cigare Volant, Bonny Doon Vineyard, £105.00  
Central Coast, California

Randall Grahm's brilliant take on Châteauneuf which now owes more to Northern Rhône or even Burgundy. Made from Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault and Mourvedre.

2014 Côte Rôtie, "Pas de Deux" Domaine St Cosme, £89.00  
France

Wonderfully supple and aromatic expression of Northern Rhône Syrah

2011 Vosne-Romanee 'Aux Réas', Domaine A.F, France £105.00  
Lovely gentle maturing Pinot.

2005 Château Haut-Bergey, Pessac-Leognan £68.00  
This wine has the lovely cedarwood and spice quality of some Groves wines. Nicely mature in this excellent vintage.

2008 Château Grand Puy Lacoste, Pauillac, £115.00  
"A lovely lifted bouquet of blackberries, blood orange, crushed stone, cedar and tar." 92pts Neal Martin
